- **Begin** quickly studying the Bible.


Before You Begin

Setup & Download Logos Bible Software

Step 1: Create account


1. Visit logos.com in your web browser of choice.
2. On the upper right hand corner, click **Sign In**.
3. At the next screen, click **Create Account**.
4. Input email address.
5. Logos will send a verification email to the email address you provided. Click on link to verify email (See *image below*).
6. Create password for Logos account.

Step 2: Download installer


7. Visit <https://www.logos.com/get-started>.
8. Click **Download** (computer type will show in parentheses)



Download button (for M-series Mac)


Step 3: Install & log in

9. Once downloaded, open software file (If on a PC, file will end in .exe; if Mac, will end in .dmg).
10. Drag Logos icon into Applications folder.
11. Click on Logos icon to start software.
12. When prompted, log into Logos account and begin software installation.

1. Navigate to **Guides/Workflows** on left sidebar.



2. Under Workflows, click on **Basic Bible Study**.
